## OPEN CLASSROOM EXPERIENCE

**Get insights to how academic lessons are conducted in SOTA!**  
\*Pre-registered participants are required to proceed to the respective venues 10 minutes before the scheduled start time. Subject to availability, walk-ins will be admitted 5 minutes before the session begins.  
Session 1: 10.45am - 11.15am  
Session 2: 2.30pm - 3.00pm

**English Language and Critical Thinking, and Theory of Knowledge**  
Level 5, Classroom Y5 (C5-20)  
Session 1: This session will explore Perspective-taking in English Language and Critical Thinking lessons

Session 2: In this session, teachers will demonstrate the use of the 'Making Thinking Visible' approach towards developing a response to a Theory of Knowledge exhibition

**Humanities and Social Sciences**  
Level 5, Classroom Y2 (C5-17)  
In this open classroom session, check out the demonstration of the study of earthquakes using the "Shake It Out" structure constructed by SOTA Geography students.

**Literature in English**  
Level 5, Classroom Y3 (C5-18)  
Literature teachers will conduct a mini activity to introduce the analysis and close reading of a literary text. This will be followed by a sharing by current IB students on their holistic experience of the subject. The session will then close with a short Q&A.

**Mathematics**  
Level 5, Classroom Y4 (C5-19)  
In this open classroom session, participants will experience learning through a hands-on approach, where tangrams are used to prove the Pythagoras' Theorem.

**Mother Tongue Languages**  
Level 10, Computer Labs 1 and 2  
Storyboarding about Youth Life: Mother Tongue language teachers will conduct a technology-assisted language acquisition activity that leads to picture book making.

CL sessions will be conducted in Mandarin for both sessions. Non-CL sessions will be conducted by Hindi, Tamil, and Malay language teachers following a briefing in English.

**Sciences**  
Level 10, Biology Lab  
In this laboratory session, participants will be exposed to learning through inquiry and be introduced to various science concepts through interactive activities.

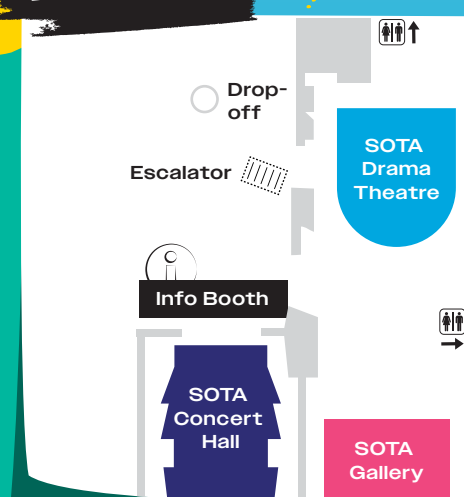

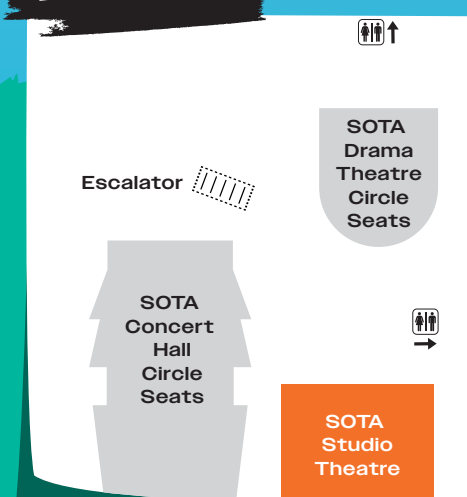
Complete a self guided tour around our campus to uncover the final location to redeem a mystery gift, while stocks last!

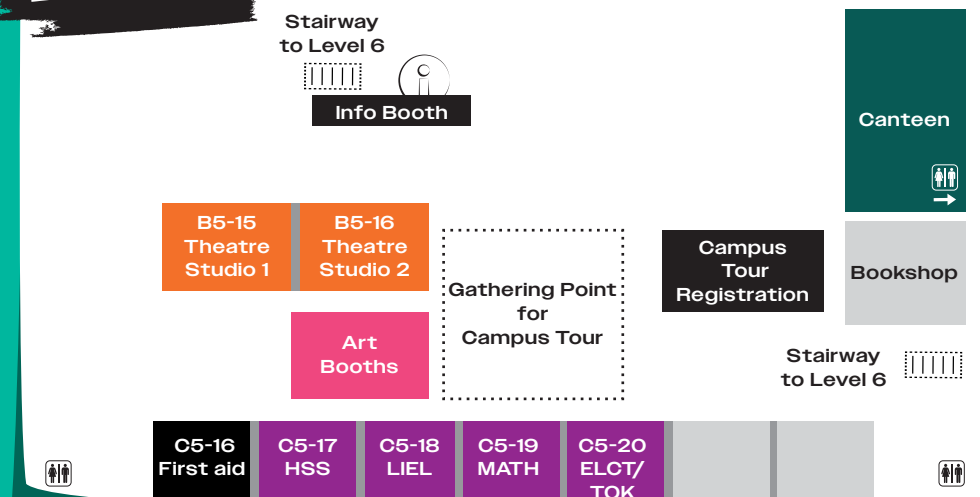

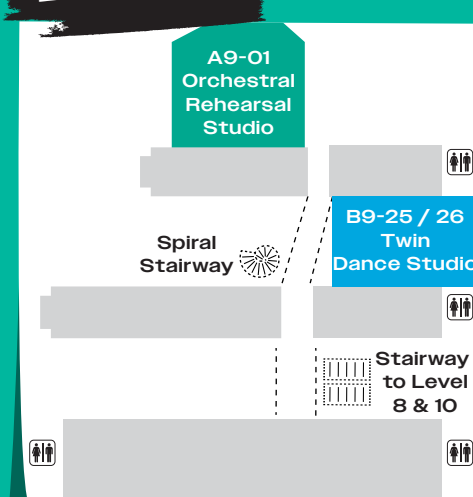

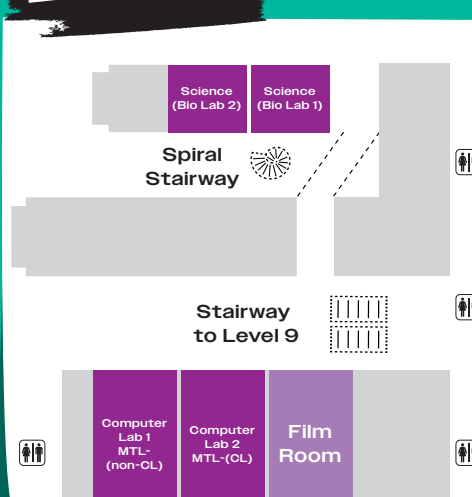
