**(A) Checklist**

**(A.1) for Submission of Supporting Documents to be uploaded via the TA Portal**

- It takes about 45 minutes to 1 hour to complete the entire application for **ONE** (1) artform, provided that the portfolio submission and all supporting documents have been prepared in advance.
- Submit your applications early, as the TA Portal may experience slower connectivity due to high traffic towards the close of the application period.
- There will be no extension of deadline for submission of application. Incomplete applications will be disqualified. Appeals for late submissions will not be considered.

### (B) Preparation Notes for Portfolio Submission in Dance IBDP (for all applicants)

SOTA offers a holistic dance education through a mind-body approach. Ballet and Contemporary Dance form the basis of our physical training, and dance genres such as Chinese Dance, Malay Dance, and Indian Dance are introduced in Dance Contextual Studies and Dance Analysis. Composition and improvisation modules also allow students to hone and develop their creative voice.

SOTA's IB Diploma qualification is recognised by top universities worldwide. Armed with their IB Diploma and extensive arts portfolio, SOTA students can look forward to the arts as a career or leverage their arts-enriched educational experience to embark on diverse career options such as journalism, law, architecture, and more.

To apply, you will need to meet the following pre-requisites:

- Extensive training in dance
- A high degree of self-motivation and self-discipline to embrace all aspects of dance
- Theoretical knowledge and understanding of diverse dance forms
- Advanced ability to analyze and investigate diverse dance genres
- Advanced ability to choreograph in a variety of dance styles
- Excellent standard of English (spoken and written)
- An interest in dance as a language for expression and communication is also essential

### (C) Entrance Tests – Information for Non-DSA applicants

You may refer to the local GCE 'O' level assessment books for the following subjects to familiarise yourself with the topics and exercises.

Candidates will only be required to take one of the Science tests.

The entrance tests will be scheduled on 20 June. Only shortlisted Non-DSA applicants are required to take the tests.

More information will be shared with shortlisted candidates on how the tests will be conducted.

English Comprehension and Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>You will be given 5 minutes to read the instructions carefully, and 1 hour 15 minutes to complete the test</li><li>Based on an expository text, candidates will answer a variety of questions testing close reading and comprehension skills, vocabulary in context and the use of language for impact</li><li>Based on an expository text, students will respond to an author's key arguments.</li></ul>
Mathematics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>You will be given 5 minutes to read the instructions carefully, and 1 hour 30 minutes to complete the test</li><li>No calculator or Graphic Display Calculator is allowed</li><li>Formula Booklet will be provided</li><li>Candidates must complete 10 problem-solving questions that carry a total of 80 marks</li><li>The topics that will be covered are as follows:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Prior Knowledge of Year 1 to 4 Mathematics (Elementary Mathematics and some Additional Mathematics) is required</li><li>Functions and Graphs</li><li>Quadratic Functions and Graphs</li><li>Nature of roots for Quadratic Functions</li><li>Logarithms</li><li>Trigonometry: Identities, Double Angle Formula and Trigonometric Graphs</li><li>Differentiation of Polynomials, Exponential and Logarithmic Functions</li><li>Applications of Differentiation: Increasing and Decreasing Functions and Equations of Tangents and Normals</li><li>Integration of Polynomials</li><li>Applications of Integration: Area</li></ul></li></ul>
Biology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>You will be given 5 minutes to read the instructions carefully, and 1 hour to complete the paper.</li><li>The paper consists of 2 sections. Section A contains multiple-choice questions. Section B contains short-answer and extended-response questions. The paper carries a total of 40 marks.</li><li>The topics include cells, movement of substances, nutrients, enzymes, nutrition in humans, transport in plants, heredity, molecular genetics, photosynthesis, cell respiration, gas exchange, circulatory system, homeostasis and nervous system.</li><li>A calculator is required for Section B of this paper.</li></ul>
Chemistry	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>You will be given 5 minutes to read the instructions carefully, and 1 hour to complete the paper.</li><li>The paper consists of 2 sections. Section A contains multiple-choice questions. Section B contains short-answer and extended-response questions. The paper carries a total of 40 marks.</li><li>The topics include kinetic particle theory, measurement and experimental techniques, elements, compounds and mixtures, the periodic table, atomic structure, chemical bonding and structure, stoichiometric relationships, acids, bases and salts, energetics, chemical kinetics, equilibrium, redox processes, the atmosphere and environment and organic chemistry.</li><li>A calculator is required for Section B of this paper.</li><li>The periodic table and names of elements will be provided.</li></ul>

Physics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• You will be given 5 minutes to read the instructions carefully, and 1 hour to complete the paper.</li><li>• The paper consists of 2 sections. Section A contains multiple-choice questions. Section B contains short-answer and extended-response questions. The paper carries a total of 40 marks.</li><li>• The topics include physical quantities and measurements, temperature and transfer of thermal energy, kinetic theory and thermal properties of matter, vectors and kinematics, dynamics, energy, work and power, other effects of forces, waves and electromagnetic spectrum, light, electric field and current of electricity, electric circuits, electric power, magnetism, electromagnetic induction and atomic structure and radioactivity.</li><li>• A calculator is required for Section B of this paper.</li><li>• A list of constants, multipliers, circuit symbols and formulas will be provided.</li></ul>
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## (D) Audition Details for Shortlisted Applicants

### (D.1) What You Will Experience During the Talent Academy

You will be required to participate in and complete the following compulsory activities in SOTA:

1. Entrance Tests (for Non-DSA candidates only)
2. Panel Interview and Online Questionnaires (no preparations required)
3. Dance Auditions:
  - a. Ballet Class
  - b. Contemporary Dance Class
  - c. Creative and Writing Task
  - d. Art form interview

**Note:** Although pre-audition video submitted can be in any genre of dance, all shortlisted applicants will undergo the above-mentioned activities in the Talent Academy.

### (D.2) How to Prepare for Dance Audition

Preparation for the Audition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Practise Exercise 1 and check that you get stronger, more flexible and gain more control each time you practise.</li><li>• Practise learning different exercise combinations in Ballet and Contemporary Dance (e.g. from online dance classes)</li></ul>
On the Dance Audition Day	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Come with an open mind; be ready and willing to try the activities prepared for you at the audition</li><li>• Be dressed in the appropriate gear and be neatly groomed</li><li>• Approach the audition as you would a public performance</li></ul>
Attire (Annex A)	<p><u>Female</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Leotard (any colour)</li><li>• Convertible ballet tights or leggings (cut out at the soles)</li><li>• Ballet/dance slippers</li><li>• A towel and something to keep warm (e.g., a tracksuit)</li><li>• Hair should be pulled away from the face and neatly tied into a bun</li></ul> <p><u>Male</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Form-fitting sleeveless top (any colour)</li><li>• Opaque coloured tights /bicycle shorts</li><li>• White socks (lightweight sport socks – above ankle, below calf muscle)</li><li>• Canvas ballet flats/dance slippers</li><li>• A towel and something to keep warm (e.g., a tracksuit)</li><li>• Hair should be neatly groomed</li></ul>

### (D.3) What to Bring

Entrance Tests (Non-DSA/Grade 10 candidates only)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A copy of your TA Schedule.</li><li>• Student Concession Card (studying in Singapore) or a copy of your Passport (residing overseas).</li><li>• All writing materials will be provided for you.</li></ul>
TA Schedule 1 (Page 8)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A copy of your TA Schedule.</li><li>• Student Concession Card (if you're studying in Singapore) or a copy of your Passport (residing overseas).</li><li>• Come in your audition attire (Annex A). You may wear a sweater/jacket and skirt/pants over your audition attire as you will be in air-conditioned venues.</li></ul>
TA Schedule 2 (Page 8)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A copy of your TA Schedule.</li><li>• Student Concession Card (if you're studying in Singapore) or a copy of your Passport (residing overseas).</li><li>• Wear comfortable clothing. Bring a sweater/jacket as you will be in air-conditioned venues. No shorts/short skirts, singlets, sandals or slippers are allowed.</li></ul>
Note	<p><b>Food</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The canteen will be operating from 21 June – 23 June.</li><li>• At least 1 halal stall and 1 drink stall will be operating (vegetarian stall not opened).</li><li>• You may bring packed food and drink.</li></ul> <p><b>Movement &amp; Safety</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A group of SOTA students will be accompanying you throughout your day in SOTA.</li><li>• You will also be with a group of other candidates.</li><li>• Always remain with your group.</li><li>• Always inform one of the SOTA students if you need to use the restroom or if you have left any items at the previous venue. Most importantly, have fun and make friends.</li></ul> <p><b>Release from SOTA</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• All candidates who have completed all scheduled activities for the day will return to the assembly hall.</li><li>• When you're ready to leave, present your TA schedule to the SOTA staff.</li><li>• The SOTA staff attending to you will stamp and date your release time on your TA Schedule.</li><li>• Make your way to the level 5 gantry to exit the school. You will be asked to show your TA schedule by the security officer at the gantry for proof of stamp and release time.</li><li>• You are strictly not allowed to use your mobile phone for the entire duration of the TA.</li></ul>

- Dance, Film, Literary Arts, Music, Theatre: Panel interview and Online Questionnaires. No preparation required.
- Visual Arts: portfolio presentation and interview. Bring your portfolio. Panel interview. No preparation required.

- Candidates studying overseas – a copy of your passport.
